One feature of the change is that you will no longer need to be logged in to your MCLS account in order to register for training. All of our MCLS member and non-member libraries are pre-loaded, and you will simply select your institution during registration. Your member status will be listed, and you'll be able to choose between Bill My Institution or Credit Card Payment options.
