### **Primary Responsibilities:**

Participate as an active, effective member of the Shared Library Systems team. Assist with planning, implementing, and supporting MeLCat including through training.

#### **Characteristic Duties:**

- 1. Provide support to MeLCat participants through the MeLCat helpdesk
- 2. Provide support to RIDES participants through the RIDES helpdesk
- 3. Plan, organize, and coordinate MeLCat training (in-person and virtual)
- 4. Develop training materials
- 5. Coordinate documentation efforts for MeLCat
- 6. Assist with planning for new MeL services and implementation of enhancements
- 7. Work on other MeL components or other projects as assigned

#### **Related Duties:**

- 1. Attend MCLS virtual staff meetings; some travel to in-person meetings/trainings, or in-service meetings
- 2. Attend Shared Library Systems staff meetings
- 3. Present updates at conferences, meetings, etc.
- 4. Attend seminars and workshops related to professional growth
- 5. Participate in cross-functional MCLS committees as needed
- 6. Other duties as assigned
