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Introduction

This RFP contains specifications and related information for the provision of services. The intent of this RFP is to find and partner with a qualified and experienced courier service to ship library materials from one participating institution to another on a statewide level.

MCLS seeks solutions related to all aspects of library delivery service including pick up, delivery, sorting, transport, labeling, packaging, routing, tracking, and reporting in order to optimize service. Library needs are time sensitive; materials must be received in a reasonable number of days, whether the materials are borrowed from a library in the same city or across the state. Delays diminish the reputation of libraries and their staff, hamper research at academic libraries, and restrict citizen's access to information.

Responses are sought that will ensure that MCLS RIDES will provide a fast, efficient, and cost-effective solution for all delivery and sorting services for Michigan libraries beginning July 1, 2016.

This RFP does not commit MCLS to award a contract, pay any cost incurred in the preparation of a response to this RFP or procure or contract for services. MCLS intends to award a contract on the basis of the best interest and advantage to MCLS. MCLS reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to accept or reject any or all responses received as a result of this RFP, negotiate with all qualified respondents, or cancel this RFP in part or in its entirety. MCLS may select the response which, in MCLS sole and absolute discretion and with any modifications MCLS and the respondent may make, best meets MCLS requirements, whether or not that response is the lowest priced. No respondent shall have any legal, equitable, or contractual right of any kind arising out of its submission of a response, except as and to the extent MCLS, in its sole and absolute discretion, shall enter into a contract with the respondent MCLS selects.

ALL CONTRACTS SUBMITTED AS A RESULT OF THIS REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL ARE SUBJECT TO THE REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF MCLS LEGAL COUNSEL.

About MCLS and RIDES

MCLS is a multi-type library consortium based in Lansing, Michigan. MCLS is a non-profit membership organization formed to facilitate sharing of resources among libraries, to enhance the availability of information resources to patrons, and to encourage libraries to institute cost-effective procedures that are made possible through interlibrary cooperation. The Michigan Library Consortium (MLC), which was formed in 1974, and the Indiana Cooperative Library Services Authority (INCOLSA), which was formed in 1995, merged on December 17, 2009 creating the Midwest Collaborative for Library Services (MCLS).

MCLS contracts with The Library of Michigan to provide training and support for the Michigan eLibrary (mel.org) services known as MeL and MeLCat. MeLCat is a shared statewide library catalog that allows patrons to request books, audio books, music, movies and other materials from libraries throughout the state of Michigan, and have those items delivered to their home participating library.

RIDES (originally known as MeL Delivery) was founded in 2004 as a service provided by MCLS to be a statewide courier delivery service offering low-cost, rapid delivery and return of materials among libraries of all sizes and types, with daily weekday pickup and delivery of physical library materials to participating libraries. http://mcls.org/rides

- MCLS is responsible for recruiting, billing, training, developing and monitoring policies and procedures, problem resolution, reimbursements, and all communication with RIDES participants, as well as acting as liaison between the courier and the participants.
- RIDES participation is open to any public, academic, school, or special library, library cooperative, school district, ISD, or REMC in the state of Michigan. See Attachment 1 – RIDES Participating Libraries.
- All MeLCat participants are required to participate in RIDES, but RIDES participants are not all required to participate in MeLCat.
- RIDES service must respond to all aspects of library delivery service including pick up, delivery, sorting, transport, labeling and packaging, routing, tracking, and reporting in order to optimize service on a statewide level. Accurate, consistent, and fast delivery is required.
- RIDES currently serves 394 individual sites. 52 of those are 'central delivery sites' serving as the
 central pick/up and drop/off locations for 'sub-libraries' that can be branches or standalone
 libraries that receive their delivery through a local delivery system run by the central delivery
 site. RIDES currently has 333 sub-libraries. See Attachment 1 RIDES Participating Libraries.
- The number of locations and/or addresses may change at the discretion of MCLS.
- Volume estimates range between 3.5 and 4 million items shipped annually.
- Participating libraries currently have the option of subscribing for service either 3 days per week, or 5 days per week. School libraries have the option of subscribing for a partial year of service, September through May.
- MCLS owns 8,000 green totes that are labeled RIDES and individually barcoded for the exclusive use of RIDES participants. There are 2,400 small 22"x15"x10" 1.4 Cu Ft totes, and 5,600 large 27"x17"x12.5" 2.3 Cu Ft totes. All items shipped with RIDES (with the exception of ROSEY materials see below) must be shipped inside a tote.

- MCLS has developed a shipping label maker currently used for RIDES. http://mcls.org/rideslabels
- Participating libraries may use RIDES to ship any circulating materials such as books, magazines, video and audiotapes, DVD, and educational kits from their collection as well as non-returnable materials, requested via the MeLCat service or other interlibrary loan systems.
- Current shipping requirements for all participating libraries are available on the RIDES Procedures web page. http://mcls.org/ridesprocedures
- Participating libraries currently have the option of either packaging all materials, or shipping books unpackaged. All AV materials must be packaged at all times.
- RIDES offers libraries the option to participate in the 'ROSEY' program, which allows libraries to
 discard unwanted materials in a simple, low cost, environmentally-sensitive way. Items left over
 from book sales or weeded from library collections may be packaged and shipped via RIDES to
 be processed through a third party vendor for resale or recycle. Cardboard cartons for shipping
 ROSEY materials are supplied by the vendor; these items are not shipped using the standard
 RIDES totes. http://mcls.org/rosey

Contract Award and Assignment:

The successful respondent shall, by March 21, 2016, enter into a negotiated contract prepared by MCLS. The contract documents shall include General Terms & Conditions and Requirements stated in the RFP along with the respondent's formal response terms.

The contract to be awarded and any amount to be paid thereunder shall not be transferred, sublet, or assigned without the prior approval of MCLS.

Respondent Instructions

- Proposals must be submitted in electronic format via email to ridesrfp@mcls.org.
- Proposals shall include the business name, address, telephone number, and web site address, along with the respondent contact name and email address.
- Proposal submissions will be acknowledged by email within 72 hours of receipt.
- Proposal modifications will be considered until the scheduled closing date for the receipt of proposals.
- Proposals may be withdrawn at any time prior to the scheduled closing date for the receipt of proposals.
- All communication from respondents, including any questions about the RFP or the process itself should be directed to ridesrfp@mcls.org, not to MCLS staff. Violations of this provision by respondent or interested parties may result in the rejection of their proposal. Any substantive questions and the answers provided in response will be posted to http://mcls.org/ridesrfp.
- Respondents are expected to examine the complete RFP document and all attachments. Failure
 to do so is at respondent's risk. It is respondent's responsibility to ask questions, request
 changes or clarifications, or otherwise advise MCLS if any language, specifications or
 requirements of this RFP appears to be ambiguous, contradictory, and/or arbitrary.
- By submitting a response, the respondent certifies that they have read and fully understand all
 proposal specifications, plans, and terms and conditions, and agree to provide the specified
 services in the RFP at the prices quoted, pursuant to all requirements and specifications
 contained therein.
- Unless otherwise specifically stated in the RFP, all specifications and requirements constitute
 minimum requirements. Proposals must meet or exceed the stated specifications or
 requirements. Unless specifically stated all pricing submitted in response to this RFP is firm and
 fixed. Unless specifically stated it is assumed that any comment, statement, or requirement not
 otherwise objected to by the respondent is agreed to by the respondent.
- Any, all, or no respondent may be required to appear before MCLS to explain the respondent's
 understanding and approach to the project and/or to respond to questions concerning the
 proposal. MCLS reserves the right to request information from respondent as needed. If
 information is requested, MCLS is not required to request the information of all respondents.
 Respondents selected to participate in negotiations may be given an opportunity to submit a
 revised technical and/or cost proposal/offer, subject to a specified cut-off time for submittal of
 revisions.

- MCLS encourages respondents to be creative in their proposals and provide alternatives to
 accomplish the desired or intended results of this procurement. Multiple options may be
 proposed. However, proposals which depart materially from the terms, requirements, or scope
 of work defined in this procurement will be rejected as being non-responsive.
- The respondent hereby certifies:
 - That this proposal is genuine and is not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed person, firm or corporation, and is not submitted in conformity with any agreement or rules of any group, association, or corporation;
 - That the respondent has not been directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other bidder to put in a false or sham proposal;
 - That the respondent has not sought by collusion or otherwise to obtain an advantage over any other bidder or over MCLS.

General Terms and Conditions

These standard provisions will be incorporated into any contract that is awarded as a result of this RFP.

Verify compliance with the following requirements or provide a detailed explanation and counter offer.

Governing Laws and Regulations

The Contractor shall construe the contract as according to the laws of the State of Michigan. Additionally, the Contractor shall comply with all local, state, and federal laws and regulations related to the performance of the contract to the extent that the same may be applicable.

Taxes

The Contractor shall assume and pay all taxes and contributions including, but not limited to, State, Federal and Municipal which are payable by virtue of the furnishing and delivery of item(s) specified herein. Materials and services purchased by or furnished by MCLS are not subject to either Federal Excise Taxes or Michigan Sales Tax.

Equal Opportunity and Nondiscrimination

The Contractor and all subcontractors shall agree not to discriminate against any recipients of services, or employees or applicants for employment because of race, creed, color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, physical handicap, age, height, weight, marital status, veteran status, religion and political belief (except as it relates to a bona fide occupational qualification reasonably necessary to the normal operation of the business). The Contractor shall comply with federal laws, rules and regulations applicable to subcontractors of government contracts including those relating to equal employment of minorities, women, persons with disabilities, and certain veterans. Contract clauses required by the United States Government in such circumstances are incorporated herein by reference.

Insurance

The Contractor will at all times maintain and keep in force a policy of general liability insurance of \$1,000,000/\$2,000,000 for personal injury, automobile insurance of \$1,000,000 and \$3,000,000 for property damage. The Contractor shall maintain insurance to cover the eventuality that all library materials in the custody of the Contractor at facilities, on vehicles, or in custody of a subcontractor are lost due to an accident, fire, or any other catastrophe. The Contractor shall meet Workers Compensation at required Michigan State levels. Certificates of Insurance for all Contractors must be filed with MCLS before any vehicle performs delivery under this agreement. Upon renewal, certificates of insurance must be filed with MCLS. All policies shall provide MCLS thirty (30) day notice of cancellation, non-renewal, or material change. Any lapse in insurance coverage is cause for breach of any contract.

Initial Contract Period

The initial contract service period shall be July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2019. The contract shall not bind, nor purport to bind, MCLS for any contractual commitment in excess of the initial contract period. MCLS shall have the right, at its sole option, to renew the contract for additional three-year periods, or any portion thereof. In the event MCLS exercises such right, all terms and conditions, requirements and specifications of the contract shall remain the same and apply during the renewal period, pursuant to applicable option clauses of this document.

Payment and Invoicing

The Contractor must submit an itemized monthly invoice itemizing the cost for MCLS to lacrossj@mcls.org. Payment terms will be considered to be Net thirty (30) days after the date of satisfactory delivery and acceptance by MCLS and upon receipt of correct invoice, whichever occurs last. The Contractor shall understand and agree that the individual service locations will be invoiced by MCLS. The Contractor shall understand and agree that the number of locations and/or addresses may change at the discretion of MCLS and that MCLS shall provide the Contractor with a minimum advance notice of ten days in the event the number of locations or a location address is changed. The Contractor shall maintain, during the term of the contract, all books of account, reports, and records in accordance with generally accepted accounting practices and standard for records directly related to this contract.

Contract Termination for Cause

In the event the Contractor violates any provisions of the contract, MCLS may serve a thirty (30) day written notice setting forth the violations and demanding compliance with the contract. Unless within ten (10) days after serving such notice, such violations cease and satisfactory arrangements for correction are made, MCLS may terminate the contract by serving written notice upon the respondent. The liability of Contractor for such violation, and for any and all damages resulting therefrom, as well as from such termination, shall not be affected by any such termination.

Contract Termination for Convenience

MCLS reserves the right to cancel the contract by giving written notice to the Contractor thirty (30) days prior to the effective date of such cancellation. Contractor may terminate this agreement at any time during the term by providing MCLS at least sixty (60) days prior written notice.

Indemnification

The Contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless MCLS, its officers, agents, and employees from:

- a) Any claims, damages, costs and attorney fees for injuries or damages arising, in part or in whole, from the negligent or intentional acts or omissions of the Contractor, its officers, employees and/or agents, including its sub or independent contractors, in connection with the performance of the contract.
- b) Any claims, damages, penalties, costs or attorney fees arising from any failure of the Contractor, its officers, employees and/or agents, including its sub or independent contractors, to observe applicable laws, including, but not limited to, labor laws and minimum wage laws.
- c) MCLS will not indemnify, defend or hold harmless in any fashion the Contractor from any claims arising from any failure on the part of the contractor, its employees or suppliers, regardless of any language in any attachment or other document that the Contractor may provide.

Assigns and successors

This contract is binding on MCLS and the Contractor, their successors and assigns. Neither MCLS nor the Contractor will assign or transfer its interest in this contract without the prior written consent of the other.

Respondent Background and Processes

Respond to each requirement. All proposals must include any deviations from these requirements. Responses will be included in the RFP evaluation, but not directly incorporated into the resulting contract.

- 1. State your organizational qualifications to perform the contract.
- 2. State the number of years of service the company has been in business on a statewide basis.
- 3. Provide a brief overview of your company, including who or what entity owns the company.
- 4. Describe your company hours and days of operation.
- 5. How many employees does your company have?
- 6. Describe your company security requirements for employment, such as drug tests or criminal background checks.
- 7. How many subcontractors does your company utilize?
- 8. Describe your proposed use of subcontractors, if any, to accomplish the service, remembering all responsibility for compliance with the terms of this contract and liability associated with this contract reside with the respondent.
- 9. Describe your company security requirements for subcontractor employment, such as drug tests or criminal background checks.
- 10. Has your company had any acquisitions of other courier companies within the last five years? If so, provide dates of those transactions and identify the parties and circumstances involved.
- 11. Describe and include examples of any current method of tracking shipments used by your company for verifying delivery and providing data to users.
- 12. Describe any plans to upgrade your shipment tracking process.
- 13. Provide a method and designated contact to monitor, track and resolve issues relating to any scanning or tracking services provided by your company.
- 14. Describe your billing policies and procedures for any addition and/or deletion of participating RIDES institutions.
- 15. Provide a method and designated contact to resolve questions relating to MCLS invoicing and payment.
- 16. Provide your statistics and procedures for lost item claims, including any limitations or restrictions.

- 17. Provide your statistics and procedures for damaged item claims, including any limitations or restrictions.
- 18. Provide a method and designated contact to resolve questions relating to lost and damaged items
- 19. Describe how you would organize and manage routes, transfer materials between routes, and deliver to all participant locations.
- 20. If your proposed service is comingled, as opposed to a dedicated system that would service only RIDES materials, describe how you would ensure RIDES materials will all be picked up and delivered on schedule, and protected from other materials.
- 21. Describe how you would manage service when participants can opt for a varying number of service days, ranging from 2 to 6 days per week.
- 22. Describe how you would manage service to sites with limited hours, remote locations, or other restrictions.
- 23. Describe how you would manage the temporary suspension and restoration of services for libraries that opt for Partial year participation (September-May).
- 24. Describe how you would organize and manage delivery of ROSEY items to the designated vendor.
- 25. Provide a method and designated contact to monitor, track and resolve issues relating to service, including but not limited to, missed stops, scheduled changes, expected materials that have not been delivered, and other service issues that may arise.
- 26. Provide a method and designated contact to notify MCLS of weather delays, cancellations, and any other issues that may arise unexpectedly.
- 27. Provide an overview of the proposed delivery service, including a project plan for the administration of service, including a description of any required labelling, packaging, sorting, and delivery procedures different from those described in this RFP.
- 28. Describe potential optional services, such as but not limited to, dedicated stops, premium service, overnight delivery, 6 days per week service, or the number of days per week service options.
- 29. Provide a proposed delivery schedule within 10 working days of award of contract. The final schedule will be developed with the successful respondent.

Service Specifications

Responses to these specifications will be incorporated into any contract that may be awarded as a result of this RFP.

- 1. Verify compliance with the following requirements or provide a detailed explanation and counter offer.
 - a. Indoor sorting and storage facilities.
 - b. Delivery vehicles must be appropriately sized for the volume at each location served.
 - c. Delivery vehicles must be covered to protect material from the elements.
 - d. Driver will accept RIDES totes or ROSEY boxes weighing up to 40 pounds in weight.
 - e. Driver will wear identification or company uniform during all service stops.
- 2. Verify compliance with the following service requirements or provide a detailed explanation and counter offer.
 - a. Driver must stop at each location scheduled for delivery and pickup regardless of whether or not the driver has any materials to deliver.
 - b. If a stop is missed due to weather, road conditions, or driver breakdown, courier must notify MCLS as soon as possible.
 - c. If a stop is missed, delivery and pickup service must be reconciled within one business day.
 - d. Driver must deliver all materials to the destination library within 48 hours of the material arriving at the servicing warehouse.
 - e. Driver must pick up all materials that are ready to be shipped by the library.
 - f. If the driver is unable to deliver or pick up all prepared materials, a plan must be in place to complete delivery and pickup within one business day.
 - g. All deliveries, except for any oversized single items, and ROSEY items that will be delivered to Better World Books, will be inside the green RIDES totes.
- 3. Describe the days and hours you propose for delivery service to sites, for example, 8am 5pm Monday through Friday.
- 4. List the holidays your service is closed.
- 5. Describe the anticipated average turnaround time for materials to be picked up from a shipping library and delivered to the receiving library. Include averages for materials shipped within the Michigan Lower Peninsula, for materials shipped between the Michigan Lower Peninsula and the Michigan Upper Peninsula, and for materials shipped within the Michigan Upper Peninsula.
- 6. Provide a firm, fixed price for the initial contract period and a maximum price for each potential renewal period for providing services as required. All costs associated with providing the required services shall be included in the stated price(s) unless otherwise stated. Respondents may propose pricing methods such as per delivery stop, flat pricing, or other, with the exception of per piece pricing. Proposed pricing other than per stop should provide details about the method used to determine the price.

- 7. Potential options for service include:
 - a. Option 1: <u>Dedicated</u> RIDES system with a minimum of 2 service stops per week. Participant choice of 2, 3, 4, or 5 service stops per week.
 - b. Option 2: <u>Dedicated</u> RIDES system with a minimum of 2 service stops per week. Participant choice of 2, 3, or 5 service stops per week.
 - c. Option 3: <u>Comingled</u> RIDES system with a minimum of 2 service stops per week. Participant choice of 2, 3, 4, or 5 service stops per week.
 - d. Option 4: <u>Comingled</u> RIDES system with a minimum of 2 service stops per week. Participant choice of 2, 3, or 5 service stops per week.
 - e. Other options: Respondents are encouraged to develop alternatives.
- 8. Respondents must include pricing for any optional services offered. Optional services may include:
 - a. Dedicated stop
 - b. Overnight delivery
 - c. 6 service stops per week
 - d. Respondents are encouraged to develop alternatives.
- 9. Describe any fuel price surcharge or schedule.

Contractor Service Performance Guarantee Requirements

Respond to each requirement. These requirements will be incorporated into any contract that may be awarded as a result of this RFP. All proposals must include any deviations from these requirements.

When necessary, MCLS will provide the Contractor notice of any deductions fourteen (14) days prior to the anticipated monthly invoice. The Contractor may dispute the deduction prior to the issuance of the monthly invoice.

1. Missed stops

- a. The Contractor will guarantee that 98 percent of scheduled stops will be made on the date scheduled, with consideration for weather, road conditions, or driver breakdown. If possible, the Contractor will reconcile the missed stop by the following day. Long-term road or library construction that may hinder access will prompt changes to the delivery schedule that are acceptable to all parties.
- b. MCLS will calculate the number of missed stops based on the number of contracted stops, available scanning data, and the number of missed stops reported by the participating library, that have not been reconciled.
- c. For each missed stop more than the allowable number within a single monthly billing period, the Contractor will be assessed \$15, per missed stop, until service has been restored to the expected level.

2. Failure to deliver all items

- a. The Contractor will guarantee to have all material that arrives at the servicing warehouse sorted and delivered to the destination library within 48 hours, or on the next scheduled service day.
- b. If any delay reported by a participating library cannot be contributed to a misrouted, mislabeled or library holding issue, or if a participating library reports an unusually large number of totes delivered, which is indicative of stockpiling, the Contractor will be assessed a \$200 service fee, per incident.

3. Failure to pick up all materials ready for pick up

- a. The Contractor will guarantee all prepared totes will be picked up every scheduled service day, or make arrangements to pick-up the remaining items as soon as possible, preferably later the same day.
- b. If a participating library reports that not all of their material was picked up, and the outbound volume does not exceed their normal daily volume, the Contractor will be assessed \$10, per incident.
