




Although its borders enclose an area greater than that of all New England, the U.S. state of Washington is the smallest on the Pacific seaboard. With the exception of California and Hawaii, it is more densely populated than any other Western state. Each year its permanent residents are outnumbered by out-of-state visitors—and many of these tourists are so attracted by its scenic and civic charms that they return to stay.


Much of Washington's rapid growth has been due to the abundance of natural resources—chiefly the mighty Columbia River. The waters that spring from the mountains of Washington have been harnessed to make it the nation's foremost producer of hydroelectric power. 

Through her eyes the event becomes fresh, heavy, and palpable, but at times 9/11 appears to be a competing rather than complementary protagonist. The cadences of the fifth-graders flow almost like slam poetry, emphasizing their feelings and senses over drawn-out descriptions or narration. This tender retelling of tragedy is a solid vessel to help young readers understand the gravity of 9/11 and how it touches all Americans, no matter where we come from.
